

**MINUTES OF  
LOWER ELKHORN NATURAL RESOURCES DISTRICT  
BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING**

The Board of Directors Meeting of the Lower Elkhorn Natural Resources District was called to order by Chairman Joel Hansen on Thursday, December 18, 2014 at the Lifelong Learning Center, 601 East Benjamin, Norfolk, Nebraska. Chairman Hansen informed the Board and those attending of the Publication of Meeting Notice in the Norfolk Daily News on December 12, 2014 and the Nebraska Open Meetings Act information posted.

Roll call was taken by Administrative Assistant Vickie DeJong with 11 of 13 Directors present. Present: Anderson, Carlson, Gustafson, Huntley, Kluthe, Loftis, Meyer, Schultz, Shelton, Tighe, Hansen. Absent: Krueger, Zessin. Motion was made by Shelton and seconded by Loftis to excuse the absence of Mike Krueger and Rod Zessin. Aye: Anderson, Carlson, Gustafson, Huntley, Kluthe, Loftis, Meyer, Schultz, Shelton, Tighe, Hansen. Nay: None. Absent: Krueger, Zessin. MOTION CARRIED.

Motion was made by Kluthe and seconded by Shelton to adopt the agenda. Aye: Anderson, Carlson, Gustafson, Huntley, Kluthe, Loftis, Meyer, Schultz, Shelton, Tighe, Hansen. Nay: None. Absent: Krueger, Zessin. MOTION CARRIED.

A Public Hearing was held regarding the adoption of Chemigation Rules and Regulations. Motion was made by Anderson and seconded by Huntley to open the Public Hearing on the adoption of the Chemigation Rules. The Public Notice for the hearing was in the Norfolk Daily News on November 29, 2014, December 3, 2014 and December 10, 2014. No comments were received from the public. Motion was made by Shelton and seconded by Kluthe to close the Public Hearing on the adoption of the Chemigation Rules. Discussion followed. It was noted that the chemigation permit fees established by the proposed rule (\$50 for new and special permits, \$20 for renewal permits, and \$250 for emergency permits) are sufficient to cover the reasonable costs to the District to administer the permit program under the Chemigation Act.

Motion was made by Shelton and seconded by Loftis to approve the proposed Lower Elkhorn Natural Resources District Chemigation Rules and forward the approved rule and all other necessary documentation to the Director of the Nebraska Department of Environmental Quality for their consideration and approval. Nominated for Voting Delegate was Bob Huntley. Nominations Ceased. After ballots were counted it was announced that Director Bob Huntley was elected Voting Delegate. (Huntley - 11)

Nominated for Voting Alternate was Mike Krueger. Nominations Ceased. After ballots were counted it was announced that Director Mike Krueger was elected Voting Alternate. (Krueger – 11)

The Nebraska Natural Resources Commission report was given by Garry Anderson. He reported the next meeting of the Commission will be held on January 28<sup>th</sup>.

A Natural Resources Conservation Service report was given by Robin Sutherland. (A copy of the report attached to the official minutes.)

Bob Huntley gave the Northeast Nebraska RC&D report and Gary Loftis gave the Loess Hills RC&D report.

The Bazile Groundwater Management Area Project report was given by Brian Bruckner with a written report by Stephanie Butler included in the packets.

The Administrative Report was given by the staff.

Due to the vacancy of the Subdistrict III director the board advertised for candidates to fill the vacancy effective January 1, 2015. One candidate applied for the position, Jarvis Otten. Chairman

Hansen reviewed the procedure for the appointment to the Board of Directors, Subdistrict III. Voting will be by voice vote according to the Nebraska Open Meetings Act. The successful candidate must have the majority of those voting, 6 votes.
