Motion was made by Gustafson and seconded by Clausen to untable the November motion - to set the 2023 allocation amounts for the Lower Elkhorn NRD Quantity Management Subareas at: 18 acre-inches per irrigated acre for gravity/flood irrigation systems, 13 acre-inches per irrigated acre for subsurface drip irrigation systems, and 14 acre-inches per irrigated acre for all other irrigation systems in the Eastern Madison County Quantity Subarea; and 17 acre-inches per irrigated acre for gravity/flood irrigation systems, 12 acre-inches per irrigated acre for subsurface drip irrigation systems, and 13 acre-inches per irrigated acre for all other irrigation systems in the Wayne County Quantity Subarea. Motion was made by Gustafson and seconded by Korth to modify the Lower Elkhorn Natural Resources District Approved Flow Meter List to only include the McCrometer Propellor Flow Meters (All Models).
